- For ISO DTR 21002 ,Multidimensional measurement and coordinate system definition‘ a ballot is started. In Annex E Table 14 channel codes are exemplary listed. The TaskForce agreed the proposed corrections of the codes. These corrections will be part of the German comments within the ballot.

MME-Forum – Additional codes

- ☐ New codes for ISO TC22 SC36 WG5 aPLI Pedestrian Legform
 - > With the schematic figures from Cellbond Peter created 2 new **IMP**-figures (p. 5,6); Dirk updates the channel codes in the DB.

- ☐ WIAMan Technology Demonstrator Codes
 - > WA, WB and WC are reserved FineLocations3 for 5% female, 50% and 95% male; Dirk creates a possible channel list in the DB; when the codes are clarified, a figure has to be created.

- ☐ LODC Large Omnidirectional Child
 - > FineLocation3 MA is accepted; Dirk prepares a proposal for the channel codes.

- ☐ EuroNCAP – Data acquisition and Injury Calculation
 - > Version 2.1 of TB021 is nearly identical to 2.0; item should remain open for the next version.

- ☐ 1157 Child Restraint coding
 - > Item remains open for further discussion as required. (Fig. SEAT_2)
