Recommendation for the data exchange

1. Current status

The ISO TS 13499 specifies no case-sensitivity for filenames or file extensions.

“Case-sensitivity is not required for description fields“ in chapter 6.1 doesn't match filenames.

MS Windows operation systems don't use case-sensitivity. But all UNIX operating systems do so.

2. Recommendation for the data exchange

Parts of filenames and extensions like the testnumber, which occur several times in the file structure, have to be identical in the usage of upper and lower case letters.
