## Summary

- **Forum**

- Acceptance
  - Up to now the forum is only used by a few registered members. Nevertheless it is an important tool for the distribution of information. Furthermore it reduces the effort and the time for the discussion within the TaskForce.
- New look and feel
  - P. Wellicome moved the ISO-MME site to a new server and upgraded the forum software phpBB.
- The structure and the handling of the forum has to be described for new users
  - P. Derpmann-Hagenstroem will send an email to [all@iso-mme.org](mailto:all@iso-mme.org) about the new structure and the handling.
- TS 13499 – the current release
  - As soon as RED B and C from Version 1.5 are complete, MME 1.5 is the current release.
  - The RED's of Version 1.4 are accessible in the new subsection "TS13499 – Archive".
- MME 1.x testdata
  - For the versions 1.4 and 1.5 new subtopics for shortened testdata sets will be posted to the correspondent sections.

- **MME 1.5**

- RED's A,D and E are ready
  - During the meeting the missing new descriptor "Transducer id" for channel data files is integrated into RED A.
  - The following sentence is added to section A.2.3.4 of RED A:  
*'The first frame of an AVI file has the number 0. It has to be considered for the calculation of the "Time zero" value.'*
  - P. Derpmann-Hagenstroem will send the files to Michele Maitre.
- REDs' B and C (respectively the MME-DB) are nearly ready
  - O. Schaar will send the files to Michele Maitre
- The next version
  - All further suggestions which cannot wait for the completion of MME 2.0 should be collected for an intermediate version 1.6. This applies also for bugfixes and updated figures.



- **MME 2.0**
  - Proposal of the main document and RED A
    - P. Derpmann-Hagenstroem presented a third proposal for the main document and the RED A based on the principles as yet agreed in the TaskForce and completed by further needs.
    - The overworked version of the proposal 4 will be posted into the public section of the forum.
  - XML versus 'classic data structure'
    - The possibility for using the XML representation in addition to the 'classic data structure' for the information files was discarded. We have to decide for only one of the formats.
  - The discussion should happen mainly between the TaskForce meetings to intensify the work at the meetings.
  
- **VSIM**
  - F. Lehmann presented the current status of VSIM
  - Status of the ISO TS 22240
    - The revised TS 22240 will be soon published by the ISO.
    - The REDs are still under construction.
    - F. Lehmann will upload a testdata set to the forum.
  
- **ToDo List**
  - The current Excel ToDo List will be distributed as an own document in the forum.
  
- **ISO/TC22/SC12/WG3 meeting**
  - P. Derpmann-Hagenstroem has to prepare a presentation about the current status and the MME 2.0 proposal.
  - P. Wellicome or K. Raguse will give the presentation on the next WG3 meeting in London.
